“Spain 2020: An Inescapable Miscegenation” Reflections on Demographic Change, the Labour Market and Immigration in Spain

The publication, *“España 2020: un mestizaje ineludible”* [*“Spain 2020: An Inescapable Miscegenation”*], by the Economics professor, Joseph Oliver, offers several different simulations for the year 2020 which indicate a need for 4 to 7 million foreign workers in the Spanish labour market. The foreseeable aging of the active population will lead to a second flood of immigration around 2020, similar to that which Spain has been experiencing in the last few years. This workshop will offer a space for debate and joint reflection on the impact of immigration on the Spanish labour market and on the different scenarios in autonomous regions.
