MASTER IN EURO-MEDITERRANEAN AFFAIRS (MEMA)-MASTER EN AFFAIRES EURO-MEDITERRANÉENNES (MAEM) 2006

This is an innovative Master's degree programme on Euro-Mediterranean affairs which aims to contribute to promoting integration between Europe and the countries to the south and east of the Mediterranean. It prepares participants to become new leaders with a genuine Euro-Mediterranean outlook, thanks to which they will have the optimum conditions to immediately begin working in public, private, local, national and international institutions.

It is a programme promoted by the MAEM/MEMA network of universities and other academic institutions throughout the Euro-Mediterranean region, which have been working together since 2001 with the support of the European Union's Interreg III B MEDOCC programme. In Catalonia it is organised by the Generalitat of Catalonia, the IEMed and the CIDOB Foundation. The languages of the programme are English and French.

After a first phase of the Master's in Terni (Italy), on the 28th of August classes began in Barcelona and lasted until the 13th of December. The third phase of the 2006-2007 courses began in January in Casablanca, and the training will be completed with professional practicums.

In this first year, this Master's programme has around twenty students from a wide range of origins (Italy, Poland, Austria, Sweden, Spain, Morocco, Turkey and Egypt).
